**Macroinvertebrados bentónicos sudamericanos. Sistemática y biología.** Domínguez E. and Fernández H.R., 2009, Fundación Miguel Lillo ed., Tucumán, Argentina, 654 p. (mayfly@webmail.unt.edu.ar)

In this book edited by Eduardo Domínguez and Hugo R. Fernández, more than 30 authors have contributed to the 17 chapters dealing with the various invertebrates orders (Ephemeroptera, Odonata, Plecoptera, Hemiptera, Megaloptera, Neuroptera y Mecoptera, Trichoptera, Lepidoptera, Diptera, Simuliidae, Chironomidae, Coleoptera, Crustacea, Acari, Oligochaeta, Bivalvia and Gastropoda). Each chapter contains a presentation of the invertebrate group, illustrated taxonomic keys and biological indications related to the invertebrates life. Two additional chapters present the sampling methods for freshwater invertebrates and their use as bioindicators. Another chapter presents a general key for insects with aquatic stages. The book is carefully printed, with black and white illustrations, drawings as well as photos. It presents important informations and selected references about the various invertebrates groups.

This book is a reference book dealing with south-American freshwater invertebrates as a whole. It will be a useful tool for all people, students, researchers..., studying these invertebrates and south-American freshwaters.
